Free Dress Standards

There will be times at Brethren when the Junior High is allowed to dress in "free dress". These times include, but are not limited to Friday's and some field trips.

Friday free dress is a privilege that is earned by those students who for the week, have had no detentions.

Although the K-5th grades have Friday free dress, their prescribed free dress is: jeans and a "Christian shirt".

**Junior High free dress is different and is meant to mean - "truly free".
We ask that:**

1. The school **standards of modesty** apply. i.e.: **no** exposed under garments, midriffs or **spaghetti strap blouses**. No skin tight shirts or pants. No see through or revealing clothing pieces. No short shorts, skirts, skorts, or dresses.
2. Clothing should **not display coarse, vulgar** or otherwise questionable **sayings, pictures or graphics**.
3. All clothing fit properly and be well kept.
4. Sandals (may) be worn, but not flip flops.

Students who violate the free dress standard will be ineligible for free dress the following week and will have to change their clothes.
